

## **Covid-19 information for guests from the United Kingdom**

### **Entry from the UK**

#### **2G plus proof for people aged 12 years and older (from January 24)**

**Vaccinated:** from the day of the second vaccination for 270 days.

**Recovered:** the coronavirus infection did not occur more than 180 days ago. Certificate or medical confirmation. If recovered persons have been vaccinated, the first dose for 270 days from the date of vaccination counts as proof.

**AND Tested:** PCR test (72 h validity). For persons who have had a booster vaccination (3rd dose), the test is not compulsory! If there is no booster vaccination or a negative test result, registration in the [Pre-Travel Clearance](#) must be carried out and quarantine must be started immediately. Quarantine is considered to have ended as soon as a negative PCR test result is available. Children of school age (12 - 15 years) may enter the country with a negative PCR test. Proof from the so-called "Ninja Passport" or "Holiday Ninja Passport" is also valid.

### **Check-in at the accommodation**

#### **2G rule for those ages 12 and up (Geimpft - vaccinated, Genesen - recovered)**

### **During the stay**

**2G rule in almost all sectors.** Exemption: The Holiday Ninja Pass for school-age children and young people (12 – 15 years) is treated as equivalent to a 2-G certificate. The requirement for the pass is continuous testing during the holiday.

**Vaccinated:** from the day of the second vaccination, proof of vaccination certificate (valid for 270 days). ATTENTION: From 1.2.2022, the validity of the vaccination certificate of a double vaccination is to be reduced to 180 days. Booster vaccination remains valid for 270 days.

**Recovered:** certificate of segregation or medical confirmation (valid for 180 days)

**FFP2 mask requirement** in all publicly accessible indoor areas and outdoors, wherever the 2-metre distance to other persons cannot be maintained (i.e. in pedestrian zones or waiting areas).

### **Restaurants, bars & cafés, accommodation and leisure**

2G proof, guest registration in the gastronomy, FFP2 mask requirement indoors

#### **Ski lifts & cable cars:**

2G proof, FFP2 mask requirement in closed and coverable gondolas or lifts

#### **Public transportation, grocery stores, banks, petrol stations, pharmacies, post offices, ...**

FFP2 mask requirement

### **Return journey**

If you do qualify as fully vaccinated, you have to book and pay a test to be taken after you arrive in UK and complete a passenger locator form. Children aged 4 and under are exempt from taking a test. Please inform yourself before your return journey about the [currently valid regulations](#) for fully vaccinated people.
