

Covid-19 information sheet for guests from the Netherlands

Entry from the Netherlands

3G proof for persons aged 12 and over

Vaccinated: from the day of the second vaccination for 270 days. **ATTENTION:** For the 3G proof during the stay, the validity of the certificate is only 180 days! A triple vaccination is valid for 270 days.

Recovery: the coronavirus infection did not occur more than 180 days ago. Certificate or medical confirmation. If recovered persons have been vaccinated, the first dose for 270 days counts as proof for the entry.

OR Tested: PCR test (72 h validity), antigen test (24 h).

If there is no 3G proof, registration in the [Pre-Travel Clearance](#) must be carried out and quarantine must be started immediately. Quarantine is considered to have ended as soon as a negative PCR test result is available. Detailed information is available on the website of [the Austrian Embassy in The Hague](#).

Check-in at the accommodation

FFP2 masks are mandatory in all publicly accessible indoor areas. Please note that during the current winter season, accommodation establishments continue to apply stricter rules – such as a 2 or 3 G proof.

During the stay

The FFP2 mask requirement is mandatory for people aged 14 and over in all indoor areas of public life. For children from 6 to 14 years and pregnant women, a simple mouth-nose protection is sufficient. **The distance and hygiene recommendations still apply.**

Shops, banks, post offices, pharmacies, petrol stations ...:

Gastronomy:

FFP2 mask requirement, except during consumption. Night gastronomy: 3G rule or FFP2 mask requirement

Leisure, Culture, Ski lifts & cable cars:

FFP2 mask requirement. Please note that during the current winter season, cable cars continue to apply stricter rules – such as a 2 or 3 G proof.

Events with more than 100 participants:

FFP2 mask requirement for assigned seating, 3G rule or FFP2 mask requirement for events without assigned seating. .

Return journey to the Netherlands

No special regulations since 23 march 2022.
